

Pasadena Foursquare Church Married Couple's Valentine Dinner

- Who:** Married and engaged couples who attend PFC (and their friends.)
- What:** A romantic evening to share with other couples in celebration of marriage.
- When:** Saturday, February 10th. Dinner reservations are at 7:00 pm
- Where:** Meet at the Sierra Madre Villa Gold Line Metro station in Pasadena, (or a station closer to your home) and enjoy a 30 minute ride to Union Station. A five minute stroll takes us to historic Olvera Street where we will enjoy fine Mexican cuisine at the "El Paseo Inn."

- Cost:** \$3.00 each for the round-trip metro ticket. \$5.00 per child for childcare. Dinners start at around \$15.00 each. (A 15% gratuity will be added.)
- Reservations:** We have reserved a dining room which will seat 76 people. We need to confirm the actual number by Wednesday, February 7th, so sign up at the tape table or call the church office before then.
- Childcare:** Childcare will be provided at PFC for \$5/child, but you MUST sign up in advance so we know how many children to plan for. Bring your child(ren) to the church between 5:00 and 6:00.
- Directions:** Enter the parking structure on Halstead St. just south of Foothill and east of Sierra Madre Villa. The walkway to the platform is on the fourth parking level. Purchase round-trip tickets from the machines before you cross to the platform. Give yourself about 10 minutes to park, purchase tickets and cross over to the platform. The trains run every 12 minutes with the last one to make it by 7:00 leaving at 6:16.
When the train arrives at Union Station, walk downstairs, turn right and exit the front of the station to Alameda St. Cross Alameda, walk up the sidewalk to Olvera St. and turn right. El Paseo Inn is halfway down on the right side at 11 East Olvera St. Phone: (213)626-1361. Identify yourself as with the group from Pasadena Foursquare Church, and you'll be shown to the room. Though you will be dining with others, the restaurant is prepared for you to order on separate checks.
After dining, you can stroll around Olvera Street (though most shops will be closed,) or simply make your way back to Union Station for the return trip. Note: the Gold Line boards from the first platform on the left as you walk through the tunnel towards the tracks. Trains depart every 20 minutes (9:32, 9:52, 10:12, 10:32, etc.)
